

Mill museum 1891/94 '30 years off'

THE owner of historic Stanley Mill near Stroud has said any plans to turn the building into a working museum are at least 30 years away.

Mark Griffiths said he was still keeping an open mind to possible uses for the listed building but said he would prefer to see it re-open as a working mill which would be open to visitors.

His views follow the announcement that English Heritage has awarded the mill £324,000 for emergency repairs.

The striking building, near King's Stanley, stopped production in 1989.
