

Another exporting coup for Stroud company 17-10-89

THE future looks bright for major Stroud employers Redler who have just won yet another important export order.

The £300,000 contract to supply conveyors and elevators to the Philippines is only the latest in a string of successes announced by the firm which employs 260 people.

It was only last month that the company announced its optimism for

the future and said it has a record order book worth many millions of pounds.

Only months ago Redler released the news of its success at home as well, with a huge dry handling equipment contract for British Salt in Cheshire.

The new order is for a flour milling installation in the Philippines.

"The islands are relatively new territory for us but the order

represents another example of the worldwide confidence our products enjoy," said Mr. Paul Jones, Redler sales director.

"Redler equipment is regularly exported to many countries throughout the world from China through Turkey to Europe."

The milling conveyors and elevators order was placed by Robinson Milling Systems of Stockport.
