**I**N Pursuance of the Standing Orders of the Honourable the House of Commons, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That a printed Copy of a BILL, now depending in Parliament, “ for making and maintaining a  
“ Railway or Tramroad from or near *Framiload Passage*, upon the River *Severn*,  
“ to *Dudbridge*, and from thence to *Brimscombe Port*, in the Parishes of *Minchin-*  
“ *hampton* and *Stroud*, and to the Iron Mills at *Avening*, with several Branches  
“ and Roads therefrom, all in the County of *Gloucester* ;” with a Map annexed thereto, of the Lines or Courses of the said Railway or Tramroad, Branches and Roads,—will be deposited, within Ten Days from the date hereof, with the  
respective Parish Clerks of the several parishes or places of *Saul*, *Fretherne*,  
*Arlingham*, *Whitminster* or *Wheatenhurst*, *Frampton upon Severn*, *Eastington*,  
*Frocester*, *Leonard Stanley*, *King Stanley*, *Stonchouse*, *Randwick*, *Stroud*, *Pains-*  
*wick*, *Minchinhampton*, *Bisley*, *Sapperton*, *Frampton Mansell*, *Rodborough*,  
*Woodchester*, *Horsley*, and *Avening* ; from, in, through, and into which, such  
Railway or Tramroad, Branches and Roads, is or are intended to be made,—for  
the inspection and examination of all persons concerned.
