

Ward progress

A 25-BED ward at Standish Hospital will be officially "topped-out" by the chairman of Gloucester Health Authority next week.

At the ceremony on Wednesday 15th November, Rennie Fritchie will be able to gauge the progress on the building. She took part in the ground-cutting ceremony last July.

The £700,000 project undertaken by Cheltenham-based Kellard Construction is running on schedule and should be finished by April next year.

The ward will provide new facilities for orthopaedic and rheumatology patients.
