A staunch nonconformist he has had a lifelong association with Rodborough Tabernacle, and he is member of the diaconate choir. He is a past chairman of the executive committee of the Glo'shire and Herefordshire Congregational Union which he still serves as a committee man.

For nearly 40 years he has been keenly interested in the Boy Scout movement and was a Scoutmaster as long ago as 1909. He was largely responsible for the formation of the Rodborough Tabernacle Troop, the first to be started in the County, and he is still a strong supporter of the scout movement, at present serving as Honorary Treasurer of the Glo'shire Scouts Association.

He has always taken an active part in local government, and after serving as a member of the Rodborough Parish Council for a long period he was elected a member of the Stroud Urban District Council for the Rodborough ward when the Stroud boundaries were extended in 1936, and has retained his membership since and was elected chairman iast month.

Besides having served as Chairman of the Highways Committee and a member of the Finance Committee he has been a member of the Stroud Water Board since it was formed, of the Joint Sewerage Committee, and of other bodies connected with the Council.

Mr. Daniels has been for a long time a valued member of the Stroud District Planning Committee, while his sympathy, has found expression in his work for the Gyde Orphanage at Painswick of which he is member of the Management Committee.

For over 30 years until recently he was a governor of the Stroud Secondary Schools. In addition he is a foundation governor and member of the executive council of Wycliffe College.
