Plans For Expansion At Daniels'

In 1961 export orders received by Messrs, T. H. & J. Daniels, Ltd., of Lightpill, amounted to about 30 per cent of the company's total business and active steps are now being taken to improve this figure in 1962.

Recently three of the firm's 75 ton multi-daylight upstroke presses were purchased by the An Sun Industrial Corporation of Hong Kong and a repeat order is anticipated. The presses are to be used for making P.V.C. floor tiles.

Another recent development, made through a subsidiary company, Daniels (B.B.A.) Ltd., of 62/63. Fenchurch Street, London, specialists in heat exchanger and steam accumulator design, is an agreement with AB Rosenblads Patenter of Stockholm by which the BBA Rosenblads plate-type heat exchanger will be built in Britain by T. H. & J. Daniels.

For some time Daniels (B.B.A.) Ltd. have been Rosenblads' U.K. representatives for this type of equipment but it has hitherto been imported complete from Sweden.

Daniels' of Stroud, recently became a public company and it is understood that this agreement with Rosenblads is one of several moves now taking place in connection witthe expansion policy of the group
