### Mr. F. W. Daniels

IT was announced today that Mr. F. W. Daniels has resigned from the board of the Stroud engineering firm of T. H. and J. Daniels Ltd. of which he was formerly chairman.

Mr. Daniels told The Citizen he had taken the step because he wanted more time to devote to his other interests and particularly that of the expanding fibre board manufacturing firm of Daniels (Cam) Ltd. of which he is chairman.

An Old Wycliffian, Mr. Daniels was a great-grandson of Thomas Daniels who founded T. H. and J. Daniels in 1840. This remained a family business until 1961 when it became a public company. He has been a member of the company's firm for more than 30 years and became chairman in 1958 when he succeeded his brother, Mr. J. Lionel Daniels, who was killed that year in a motoring accident. Three years ago he resigned from the chair and was succeeded by Mr. D. S. Robinson.

Mr. Daniels has been associated with Daniels (Cam) Ltd. for about 37 years and became a director in 1944, being appointed chairman of the board about two years ago
