Another boost for firm

A STROUD engineering firm has won another major order for its worldbeating conveyor equipment.

Redler Limited of Dudbridge has been asked to supply two "en masse" conveyors to British Salt Limited in a contract worth £110,000.

The equipment is needed to handle dry salt at the company's Cheshire plant in Middlewich and comes on the heels of a number of

similar orders over the past two years.

Redler is the UK's leading manufacturer of bulk materials handling systems and employ around 260 workers at its Dudbridge factory.

This latest order is for two conveyors with a capacity rate of 20 tonnes an hour. One is 83 metres long and the other 74 metres.

Constructed from stainless steel to protect them from corrosion, the

conveyors will replace existing Redler machines supplied 20 years ago.

The contract at British Salt includes dismantling the existing machinery and installing the new conveyors.

"British Salt Limited has again demonstrated its confidence in the reliability and dust tight construction of Redler machines and the after sales service provided," said Redler sales director Paul Jones.

Established in the 1920s, Redler Limited is currently one of the biggest employers in the Stroud area.
